

Rules and Regulations

Call For: Short film in response to FUSION / COLLISION / TRANSLATION / ADAPTATION / TRANSITION

1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1 All applicants must be 18 years or older.
- 1.2 Submissions can be made by individuals, groups and/or collectives.
- 1.3 Non-English language works should have English subtitles at the time submitted if possible.

2. CONTENT

- 2.1 Submitted video has to act in response or be influenced by one or more of the key areas:

Fusion / To make manifest of the cultural diversity of contemporary urban realities, and intervene in everyday life, work and social conditions, with contemporary arts.

Collision / To provoke discussion, and be energised by the clash of ideas.

Translation / Of the ordinary experiences of life of Eastern/Central Europeans living in Western Europe.

Adaptation / Illustrating different ways of adaptation through artistic practices – the use of arts as social intervention and as international relations.

Transition / Of contributing to a new impetus for cultural democracy in the city, and defining roles for art in the city's development – on its own terms.

- 2.2 We will accept the videos of following nature:
video art, digital art, animation, spoken word, interviews, monologue, manifest, documentation, abstraction, experiment, performance art and happenings.
- 2.3 The length of video cannot exceed five minutes.
- 2.4 Your video must not be in breach of any copyright, including music or sound contained in your entry.

3. SUBMISSION

- 3.1 Video has to be submitted to film@kalejdoskopwest.org.uk via Dropbox or WeTransfer, together with your full name and title of the video/s.

- 3.2 Accepted video formats: AVI, QT, MPEG, MP4 or WMV.
- 3.3 You must fill in an online entry form which can be found at www.kalejdoskopeastwest.org.uk/film
- 3.4 Works submitted after 30th of June 2016 will not be accepted unless the deadline is extended.
- 3.5 Each participant can enter up to three works.
- 3.6 Once the video has been submitted it cannot be withdrawn.
- 3.7 Videos of offensive and/or discriminatory nature will not be considered.

4. SELECTION

- 4.1 Submissions will be selected by a panel of creative and cultural professionals from KALEJDOSKOP EAST-WEST.
- 4.2 All successful applicants will be listed on the KALEJDOSKOP EAST-WEST website on 29th July 2016.

5. SCREENING

- 5.1 Successful films will be screened at the film launch event on the 1st October 2016, at the FROM EAST TO WEST WITH LOVE Exhibition at Glass Box, Coventry, United Kingdom.

6. PUBLIC USE

- 6.1 By submitting your work, you will give a permission to KALEJDOSKOP EAST-WEST to use your name, website link, artist statement, video description, video and/or screenshots for publicity, screening and research purposes.
- 6.2 Your name will always be credited when your work is used.
